Superintendent News

The Holidays have come and gone, again. Spring is just around the corner. Hopefully, much more rain than we had last year will come with it.

The Golf Maintenance Department has, once again, been working on a number of different projects on both courses. We have rebuilt the bridge at #16 green on the New Course. We also removed the walk bridge on #16. This spring, we will be working on a tee levelling project, starting with the white tee on #17 New Course. Additionally, we will be relocating the forward tee on #17 New Course. The tee will be moved to the right. The Golf Maintenance Staff will be installing "ins and outs" on the greens irrigation as well. This should help alleviate the wet conditions around the greens in the summer months.

We will be aerifying the New Course the week of May 5th. The Old Course will be aerified the week of May 19th. I do appreciate everyone's understanding and cooperation. I realize that it is not pleasant to play on aerified greens. Every effort is being made to minimize the disruption.

With spring around the corner, hopefully we will be receiving some much needed rain. I would like to remind everyone that it is extremely important to follow the cart rules for the day. Mud tracks left by golf carts can stay with us for a number of days, and they can affect the players behind you. Also, please remember to repair your ball marks and divots.

Our goal is to provide our property owners with the best possible golf course that we can possibly have. I believe that our efforts over the last few years are accomplishing this goal. If you have any questions or comments about the golf course, please feel free to call me at 694-0372.
